SCHOENBAR STUDENT ACTIVITIES AGREEMENT

Eligibility for Participation and Travel

- A. Be a full time student
- B. Meet requirements of Alaska School Activities Association
- C. Grade requirements:
 - 1. C (2.0) grade point average in order to travel
 - 2. No F at present.
- D. Pay a \$35.00 participation fee and participate in fundraising activities.
- E. Travel eligibility forms must be turned in 24 hours prior to departure.

Rules

- A. The use or possession of alcoholic beverages or drugs or the use of tobacco will result in being dropped from participation in that activity season.
- B. No Entry into staterooms or solarium on the ferry.
- C. No gambling for money.
- D. Not switching of housing when in host cities. Curfew regulations are set by the coach/chaperone and the host family/town and will be followed.
- E. Dress neatly and appropriately at all times.
- F. Students will follow Schoenbar attendance guidelines and procedures as outlined in the Student Handbook. A student must be in attendance the entire day or until such time as dismissed for travel in order to participate in an event that day.
- G. Students shall have a 2 hour study time each day during a trip.
- H. If a student is suspended from school, that students may be dropped from the team at the advisor's/coach's discretion.
- I. Students must be in place, on time, with proper materials at all times.
- J. Students who travel as part of a school sponsored activity are viewed as representatives of Schoenbar Middle School and must conduct themselves accordingly. School rules shall apply to all students traveling under school sponsorship whether whether it be in another town, on the ferry, or in an airplane.
- K. Uniforms and equipment, unless purchased by the student, are not to be worn or used by any students except during school sponsored practices or events in which he/she participates.
- L. Equipment issued to an athlete is his/her responsibility for return or replacement. If the equipment is neither returned, replaced or paid for, no letter shall be awarded nor shall the student be permitted to participate in any sport.
- M. Denial from participating with the team for a period of time to be determined by coach/principal may result from the following:
 - 1. Willful disobedience
 - 2. Profanity, obscenity, abusive language
 - 3. Provocation
 - 4. Fighting/assault
 - 5. Theft/vandalism/malicious mischief
 - 6. Other disciplinary situations.

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N. Additional rules and regulations may and will be added by coaches, advisors, chaperones and administrators.

Violations of any of the items listed during a trip may result in the student being returned home, accompanied by a chaperone, at their own or their parents' expense and/or being suspended from the activity.

WARNING

There are injury risks inherent in all Schoenbar activities, with minimal risks in non-athletic activities and much more serious injury risks involved in competitive athletics. Generally, an "inherent risk" is a risk incurred in a normal game played within rules on a safe facility by trained players who have had qualified instruction and who know, understand and appreciate the risks of the game. Your coach will specifically explain the risks inherent in your specific sport.

Your signature below indicates that you have read and understand the eligibility requirements, rules and have been warned of the dangers involved in participating in the specific activity for which this agreement has been signed. You further know, understand and appreciate that injuries do occur which could be severe or disabling, and you will not hold the Ketchikan Gateway Borough School District liable when there is no negligence on the part of the District.
